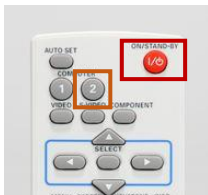

Instructions for the use of the Presentation System

To turn the projector on:

- Locate the **Projector Remote Control** on the presentation desk and press the **Power** button.
- At the start up, the **preparation screen** will display a 30 second countdown. After the countdown, the projector will display the input that is selected.



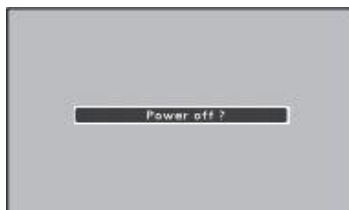
Projector Remote Control

To turn the projector off:

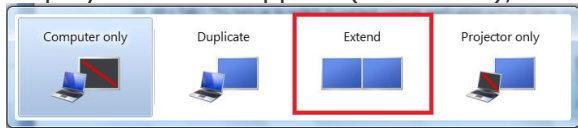
- Locate the **Projector Remote Control** on the presentation desk and press the **Power** button.
- Power Off? Will be displayed on the screen. Press the **Power** button again to turn the projector off.

To use the Presentation System

- If the computer is not on, it may be necessary to press the **Power** button located on the presentation system.
- It may be necessary to tell the desktop to direct signal to the projector. Locate the "⌘" key on the keyboard, hold it down and press the "P" key simultaneously. Windows System display mode will appear (see below), and you will want to select "**Extended**."



- The projector will automatically switch to the appropriate input.
- There are three **USB ports** available on the front of the Presentation System to use a flash drive or other USB device.

To use a Laptop



VGA Cable

- Plug the provided **VGA cable** into your laptop and properly secure.
- It may be necessary to tell your Windows laptop to direct signal to the projector. Locate the " " key on your laptop, hold it down and press the "**P**" key simultaneously. **Windows System display mode** will appear, and you will want to select "Duplicate".
- The projector will automatically switch to the appropriate input.
- If you are using a Mac laptop you will need to connect the provided VGA cable, click the upper left-hand Apple menu, select System Preferences, then Displays, and finally select "Detect Displays". Please locate your computer manual for keyboard shortcut.
